admire the lagoon from the shore or join a boat tour to get closer to the icebergs. You can also visit the nearby Diamond Beach, where chunks of ice wash up on the black sand and sparkle like diamonds

Our tour ends at the **Golden Circle**, a popular route that covers three of Iceland's most iconic

attractions: Thingvellir National Park, Geysir geothermal area, and Gullfoss majestic waterfall that plunges deep into a canyon.
